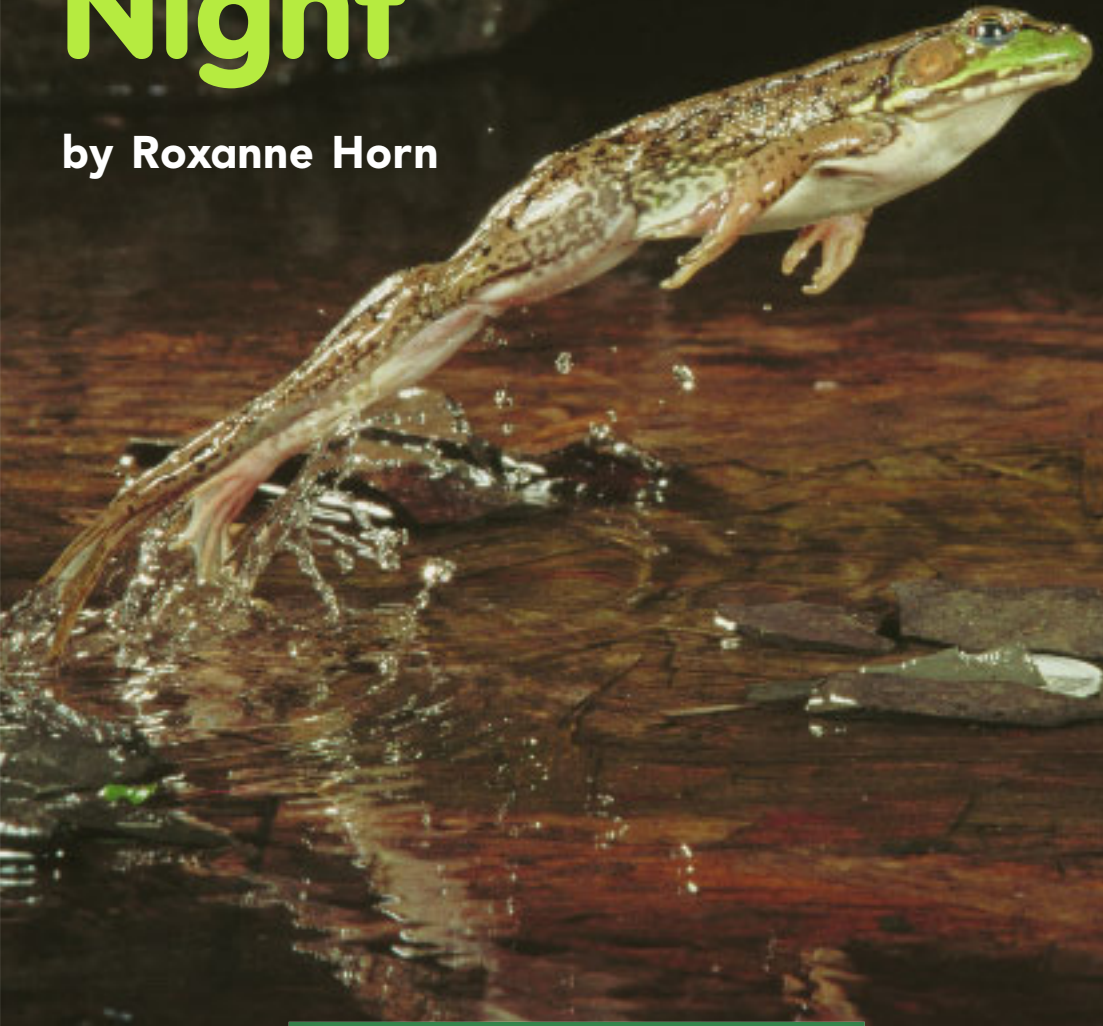

- ▶ It is looking for mice to eat.

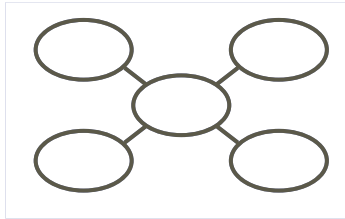
